




ONE ART Taipei 2026 Opens January 16–18! “Best Interior Design Award” Highlight: AKI Gallery

January 17, 2026, Taipei – The 8th **ONE ART Taipei 2026** is now in full swing, running from **January 16–18** at **Hotel Metropolitan Premier Taipei**. This year’s spotlight award, the “**Best Interior Design Award**,” aims to encourage participating galleries to transcend the limitations of hotel exhibition spaces and explore the interplay between art and environment through innovative curatorial approaches. Galleries redefine their rooms using **light, scale, circulation, narrative rhythm, and materiality**, turning each space into a self-contained artistic universe that offers visitors a rich, nuanced viewing experience and deepens the fair’s “**Art as Life**” immersive philosophy.

The jury for this year spans film, design, and spatial aesthetics, including **Amanda Chou** (actor, DA HSI ENTERTAINMENT CO., LTD.), **Katherine Chen** (GM, HAY Taiwan), and **Chungyi Yeh** (graphic designer, Ovalgraphic). Evaluating galleries on



spatial narrative, artwork presentation, and visitor experience, the panel selected **AKI Gallery** as the recipient of the **8th ONE ART Taipei Best Interior Design Award**, recognizing a space that pushes the boundaries of hotel-style art fairs and captivates visitors from the moment they enter.


Curated under the theme “**Inner Chambers**,” AKI Gallery transforms its exhibition room into a **spiritual sanctuary**, using enclosed and layered spaces to guide viewers toward the memories and emotions carried in the wall crevices. The exhibition focuses on **unspoken inner voices**, lingering between presence and absence, forming an intangible yet palpable landscape. Collaborating with artists including **Martin Galle, Wataru Ito, Hiroto Kitagawa, Hsin-Ying Liu, Wei Lu, Carlos Sagrera, Fujikasa Satoko, Ling-Yu Tai, and Yoshimasa Tsuchiya**, AKI Gallery employs painting, sculpture, and other media to create an intimate, elusive perceptual space where visitors are invited to listen and reflect on inner voices that remain unspoken.

Amanda Chou, one of the award jurors, noted that AKI Gallery’s exhibition layout provides ample breathing room for each artwork, with clear visual rhythm. The gallery cleverly adapts the hotel room structure, even integrating artworks naturally into the **bathroom and shower area**, blurring the line between art and daily life. The circulation is smooth, the scale comfortable, and multiple international artists’ works are harmoniously unified under a consistent spatial narrative.

The 8th ONE ART Taipei 2026 continues to explore the unique possibilities of hotel art fairs, bringing art into everyday life. Visitors are warmly invited to attend the exhibition on January 17–18, explore the unique displays of 61 galleries, and experience an unprecedented immersive journey tailored for art enthusiasts.




