The fair is set to attract collectors and art enthusiasts from Taiwan and abroad, offering an opportunity to explore the pulse of contemporary Asian art and experience the richness of cross-cultural, multi-media creations.

ONE ART Taipei Creates a Platform for Cross-Border and Diverse Art Exchange, Launches First Collaboration with Online Gallery Platform ArtSticker

【Taipei, November 28, 2025】 Since its inception, ONE ART Taipei has established itself as a premier hotel-based art fair, combining precise curatorial vision with a high-caliber exhibitor lineup to provide collectors and galleries with a professional and in-depth platform for exchange. The eighth edition, ONE ART Taipei 2026, will take place from January 16 to 18, 2026, at the Hotel Metropolitan Premier Taipei, continuing to offer an art fair experience that balances international perspective with meaningful engagement. Executive President Frank Liu stated, “The global art market has entered a new era of diversity and inclusivity. Taiwan, with its stable market foundation and rich cultural heritage, is emerging as a key hub for contemporary art in the Asia-Pacific. In response to changing collecting habits and the rise of millennial collectors, this edition of the fair is partnering for the first time with global art platform ArtSticker, extending the offline viewing experience online. Visitors can explore works in real time, engage with international galleries, and access global art trends at their fingertips, creating a seamless, integrated, and globally interactive art exchange model.

61 Local and International Galleries Gather to Showcase Cross-Cultural Diversity in Contemporary Art

This year's fair brings together a curated selection of leading galleries from Taiwan and overseas, presenting a wide spectrum of works from established masters to emerging artists. The exhibitor lineup spans Taiwan, Japan, South Korea, and Hong Kong, featuring multiple generations and artistic styles. Through an international curatorial perspective that balances depth and breadth, the fair highlights the cross-cultural richness of contemporary art and reinforces Taiwan's key role in the Asia-Pacific art market.

The edition also welcomes 17 first-time domestic and international galleries, injecting fresh energy into the fair. These include five galleries from Taiwan—DE Global Art Agency(ALEA), Kaiak.tw, Ping-Yun Palace, Marie Queen Art Space, and YI YUN ART—and 12 overseas galleries, including Gallery ANN, ArtBrunch, Gallery Baiken Kyoto, Empathy Gallery, Mio Contemporary, gallery MOS, NANJO ART GALLERY, Gallery QUADRO, Gallery TAIGADO, Third Art Gallery, Shinbuldang art center_M Gallery and SUNJAE GALLERY. Their participation enriches the visual language and diversity of works on display, collectively creating an art fair that combines international trends with forward-looking vision.



Additionally, ONE ART Taipei 2026 is collaborating for the first time with the Cultural Affairs Bureau, Tainan City Government, featuring three galleries—InArt Space, Mizuio Workshop, and Soka Art—recommended by Next Art Tainan curator Takamori Nobuo. While ONE ART Taipei has traditionally promoted emerging Taiwanese artists through private initiatives, this marks the first collaboration between private and public institutions. The partnership not only strengthens support for young artists but also expands their exposure to international fairs. This initiative enriches the fair's creative landscape and injects fresh potential into the exhibitor roster, enhancing both the depth and scope of the program.

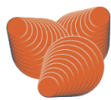

[Press Image 3] ONE ART Taipei 2026 brings together 61 galleries from Taiwan, Japan, South Korea, Hong Kong, and other regions, including galleries recommended by Next Art Tainan, showcasing a diverse and forward-looking landscape of contemporary art.

Four Curatorial Themes Showcase Contemporary Art Trends and Present a Comprehensive Vision of Creative Expression

ONE ART Taipei 2026 continues the fair's three signature curatorial themes while adopting a "3+1" structure to highlight contemporary art's market dynamics and cross-cultural creativity. The eighth edition features three main sectors—Unlimited, Discovery, and Media Art—focusing on market perspectives, emerging talent, and experimental media to fully convey the pulse and development of contemporary Asian art. A new sector, Next Art Tainan, expands support for young artists and deepens connections across cities and art ecosystems, providing a more complete and forward-looking curatorial framework.



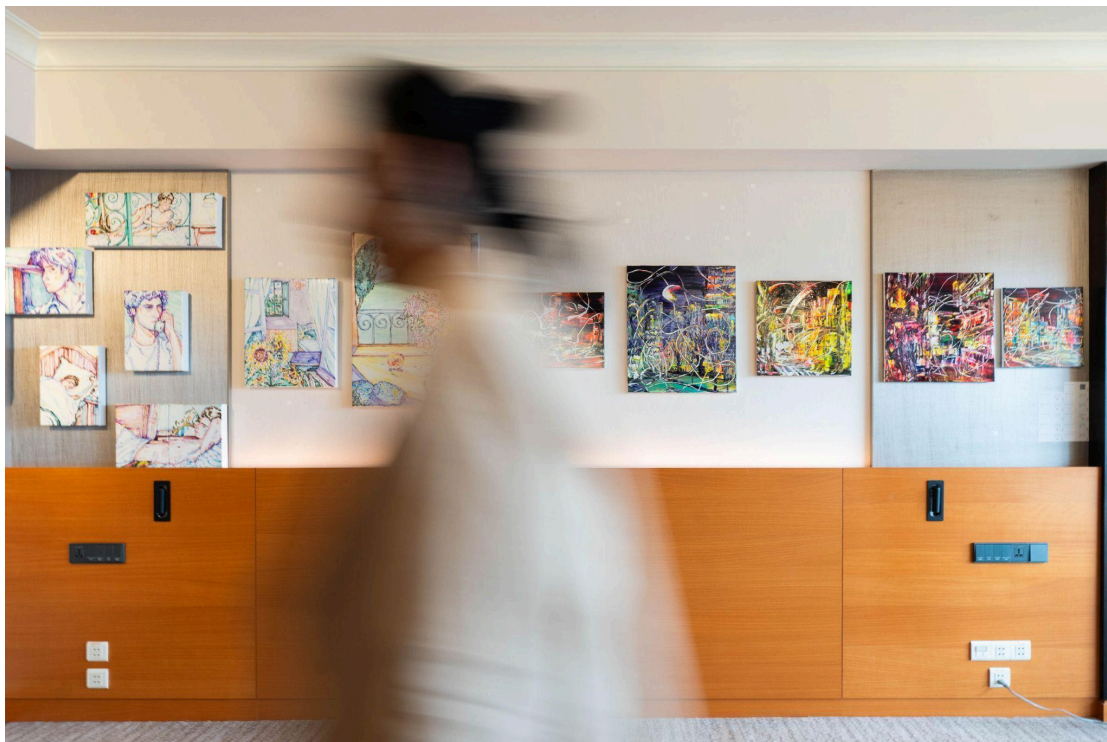
The Unlimited sector gathers leading international galleries and top contemporary artists. Dynasty Gallery presents the exhibition “Resonance Across Perspectives,” exploring how contemporary art transcends physical and psychological boundaries through multiple media and cultural contexts. Featured works include pieces by Yayoi KUSAMA from Japan, TSENG Shang-Jie, LIN Yu-Ching, WEI Hsing-Yu from Taiwan, and KOO Bon-A from South Korea, creating a cross-cultural visual dialogue that immerses audiences in a multidimensional artistic experience.

The Discovery sector continues to spotlight emerging talents under 35, presenting their creative approaches and cultural backgrounds from a new-generation perspective. Tansbao Gallery’s exhibition “Undefined Boundaries” transforms a room into a microcosmic journey intertwining tradition and contemporary, memory and future. Taiwanese artist KE Lin Yen explores contemporary ink dialogue; Tibetan artist Tenzen Gyurmey DORJEE translates migration and memory into emotional symbols; Bhutanese artist Zimbiri links history and modernity through local materials; and Nepalese artist Shraddha SHRESTHA constructs self-narratives with fantastical characters and childhood memories, showcasing the creative force of the new generation in a global context.

The Media Art sector highlights openness and experimentation through diverse media. Feihwang Gallery’s “Chasing Light” explores perception through light, objects, and bodily experience. LI Yao Cheng’s installation captures fleeting moments of light, transforming marble into a perceptual space between theater and emotion. KOYAMA Toshitaka extracts traces of human memory from aged materials such as leather and walls, reflecting the eroding effects of consumer culture, while UK-based video artist Riley TU investigates the intersections of body politics and technology, revealing tensions between human and non-human, organic and artificial, and guiding viewers through a dynamic spatial experience.

The Next Art Tainan sector focuses on the creative energy of Taiwan’s emerging artists. Grace WU of Mizuiro Workshop extends her exploration of fragmented memory and optical texture in “Falling Light,” embedding hair and feathers into grayscale landscapes to create subtle refractions visible up close. Chih CHIU of InArt Space, with a design engineering background, presents the interactive installation “Coin-operated Barber Machine,” humorously transforming human-object interaction through precise mechanisms and everyday observation. Soka Art, collaborating with LI Yin-Chen, presents “Continuity and Progress,” an experimental practice spanning ceramics, painting, and installation, using semi-liquid clay and glazes fired at high temperatures to create surfaces that hover between two- and three-dimensional space. Together, these three artists explore perception, interaction, and spatial relationships, showcasing the diverse perspectives and vitality of emerging creators.



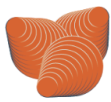

The highly anticipated ONE ART Award, recognizing emerging artists under 35, will announce its winner at the ONE ART Taipei 2026 Press Conference and ONE ART Award Ceremony on Thursday, December 18, 2025. A jury of experts from academia, collecting, curatorial, and media fields will evaluate finalists based on three criteria: artistic merit, potential, and market viability, highlighting a new generation of artists who combine contemporary language with future promise. The Best Interior Design Award encourages participating galleries to push the boundaries of hotel exhibition spaces through innovative curatorial approaches, creating thoughtfully designed booths that highlight artworks and offer visitors unique atmospheres and surprises in every room. The winner of this award will be revealed on January 17, 2026, via press release, social media, and on-site announcements.

As a leading art platform in the Asia-Pacific region, ONE ART Taipei 2026 is committed to fostering international art exchange and cross-cultural dialogue. Its hotel-based format offers an immersive viewing experience, allowing visitors to closely engage with diverse media and interdisciplinary creations, showcasing the vibrancy and diversity of contemporary Asian art. 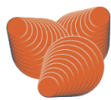

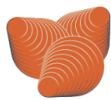
